



# ARCHITECTURAL / HDPC PRODUCT CODE SYSTEM

## Two Letters Followed By Four Numbers

### BA-1501

#### First Letter Indicates Type of Product

A = Exterior Trade Sales ----- Solvent Base	M = Industrial Maintenance-- -----Water Base
B = Exterior Trade Sales ----- Water Base	N = Government Spec. Paints -----Solvent Base
C = Interior Trade Sales-----Solvent Base	O = Government Spec. Paints -----Water Base
D = Interior Trade Sales-----Water Base	P = Ind. Maintenance Primers-----Solvent Base
L = Industrial Maintenance Coatings -- Solvent Base	X = Reworked Products -----Water/Solvent

### BA-1501

#### Second Letter Has One of Two Functions

I. Trade Sales Paint (First Code Letter A,B,C, or D) The second letter is used to indicate a family of coatings or the following code.

A = Permacryl Ext. Flat	H = High Gloss	S = Satin/Semi-Gloss
B = Flor-Cote	I = O/M Penetrating Stain	T = Rustic Tone
E = Eggshell	L = Lacquer	U = Undercoat
F = Flat	M = Misc.	W = Stain & Varnish
G = Grain Stain	N = Exterior Semi-Gloss	Z = Cote All

II. Other Coatings (First Code Letter L-P). The second letter is used to indicate the type of vehicle.

B = Alkyd	H = Rubber	U = Undercoat
C = Acrylic	I = O/M Penetrating Stain	
F = Epoxy	L = Epoxy Ester	
G = Urethane	M = Misc.	

### BA-1501

#### First Number Indicates Color

0 = Clears and Off Whites
1 = White
2 = Aluminum / Metallic
3 = Yellow
4 = Orange
5 = Red
6 = Green
7 = Blue
8 = Brown / Beige
9 = Black

### BA-1501

#### Second Number Indicates Dry Time

2 = Two Component
3 = Air Dry over 6 hours
4 = Air Dry 2 to 6 hours
5 = Air Dry 30 minutes to 2 hours
6 = Air Dry 30 minutes to 2 hours

(The last two numbers identify individual products)
